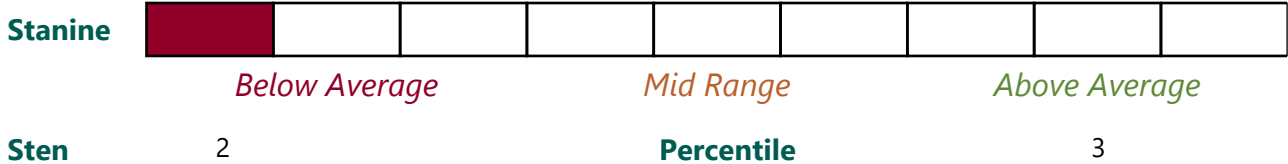

Verbatim Interpretation Guidelines

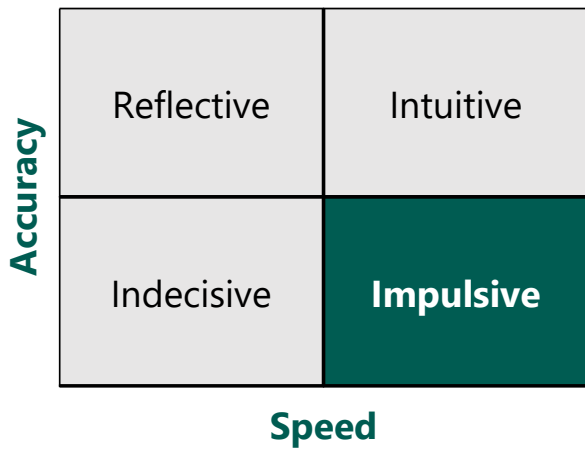
