## A LITTLE BIT MORE ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF TECHNICAL SKILLS


All future jobs and careers will require you to have technical skills. By making sure that you at least have more than just basic computer skills, you will significantly add to your chances of being successful in the modern workplace.

Those who have an interest and ability in programming, design, research, engineering and project management, will have an exceptional set of skills to provide to the workplace, similarly those who have scientific, statistical, and mathematical abilities.

This is clear when you look at the information on which careers are in high demand, or are in too high supply in the South African workforce, as illustrated in the diagram below. It is important to do some research around jobs and their availability within our South African job market. The first diagram shows the 7 job sectors which many people are looking to employ people in, with IT contributing the largest percentage. The second diagram reflects the 10 sectors with the most amount of people being able to do that kind of job (supply). The ideal situation, whilst keeping in mind your own personality, ability and interests, would be to pursue careers which are in high demand and relatively low supply.

As the following illustrates, those who aim to be successful in their careers and jobs, will need to develop and practice the following thinking, personal and interpersonal skills:



No one is born perfect, but many of the above characteristics can be developed if you take your own self-development seriously. Consider developing these skills, a few at a time, by attending workshops, or reading more about it. Consider, for instance reading the book: GRIT – The power of passion and perseverance (2016) by Angela Duckworth. She discusses the concept GRIT that refers to people who have the courage to tirelessly pursue their goals. These people work very hard and tirelessly to achieve their goals.

## LEARNERSHIPS, INTERNSHIPS, WORK SHADOWING AND MENTORING

Learnerships, internships and work shadowing, are wonderful opportunities to learn and get exposure to the world of work. See this as the start of your career and a wonderful addition to your CV. Make sure that you distinguish yourself from others with your positive attitude, your work ethic, your thirst for knowledge and learning, and your interpersonal skills. Although not all internships/learnerships can guarantee permanent employment, your attitude will draw attention and will support your chances.

Work shadowing means spending time with, and observing the work of another person in a department or role of interest, in order to gain insight into work in that area. Work shadowing provides practical career and professional development experience in a way that allows you to have a wider appreciation for a specific career.

Contact organisations or businesses to see if you can job shadow someone in that field for a day or two. This will give you a good idea of what the job is about, and if you would like to pursue it.

Identify somebody that you respect and look up to, to become your mentor. Ask them to help you understand the world of work and to support you in your personal development with fair feedback and support.



#### WORKSHOPS AND ONLINE COURSES

If you start looking around, you will come across training and workshop opportunities that could expand your knowledge and insight. Specifically seek opportunities to develop your 21st Century Skills. For personal development, look for courses on Work Readiness, Emotional and Social Intelligence, Developing your Personal Brand (offline, and on social media), Managing Job Interviews, and how to best compile your CV. Take specific care that you become very comfortable with technology, and attend training courses that provide you with the opportunity to become more confident and skilled.

Many training courses require you to personally attend the course, but there are also online courses, webinars and podcasts available to expand your knowledge. Make sure that you add those courses that you have attended to your CV.

#### PART-TIME AND VOLUNTEER WORK

Part-time work and volunteering is another great career development tool. It allows you to establish contacts, gain visibility and credibility, refine your skills and develop new competencies at your own pace, with a low level of career risk, especially if you target industries and companies in your areas of interests. Ask friends and family members about the area you are interested in, and for ideas about how to get involved.
